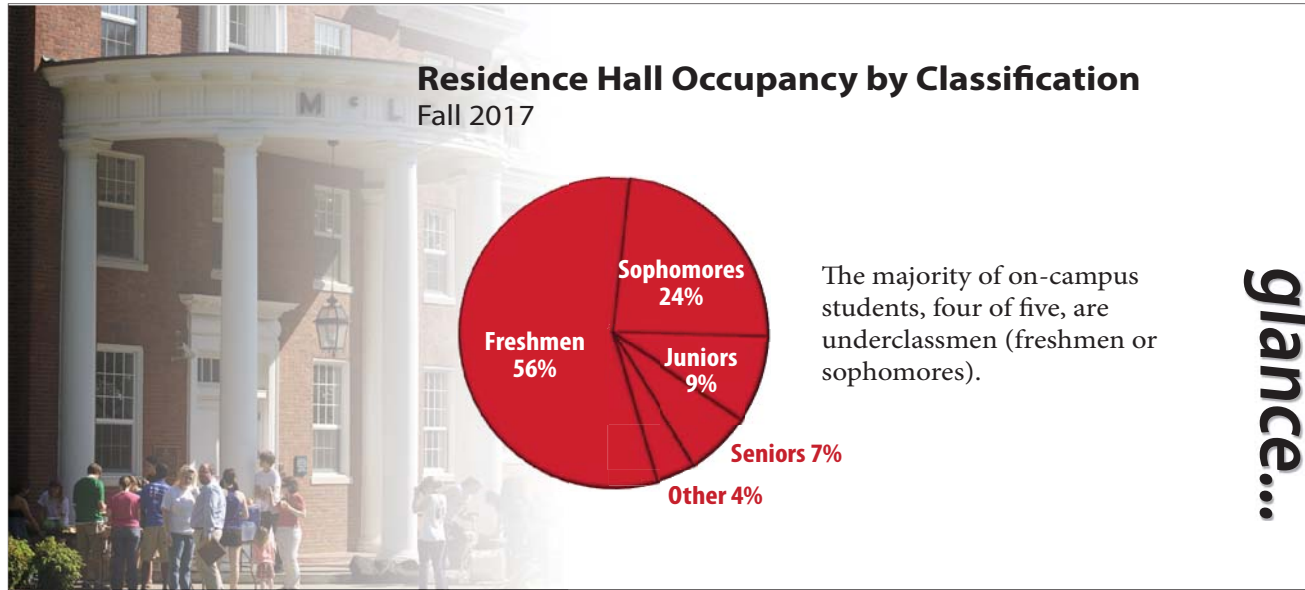

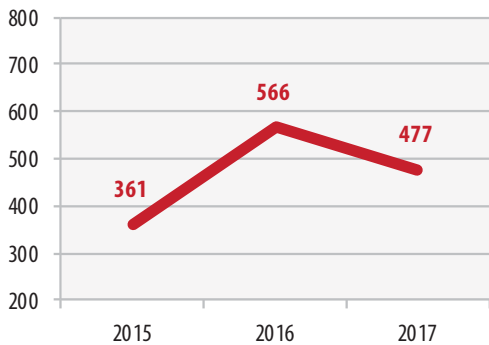

at a glance...

Criminal Offenses¹ 2015 – 2017



Total criminal offenses increased by 57% between 2015 and 2016, largely due to a 145% increase in Liquor Law Violations Referred for Disciplinary Action and a 137% increase in Alcohol Intoxication. Between 2016 and 2017 Liquor Law Violations Referred for Disciplinary Action and Alcohol Intoxication decreased by 45% and 73%, respectively. This resulted in total criminal offenses decreasing by 16% between 2016 and 2017.
