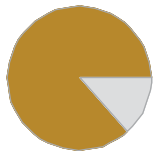
Ogden College of Science and Engineering Student Profile Fall 2013 - 2017



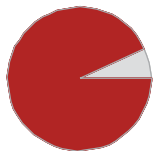
In Science and Engineering, **females** make up **37%** of the student population.

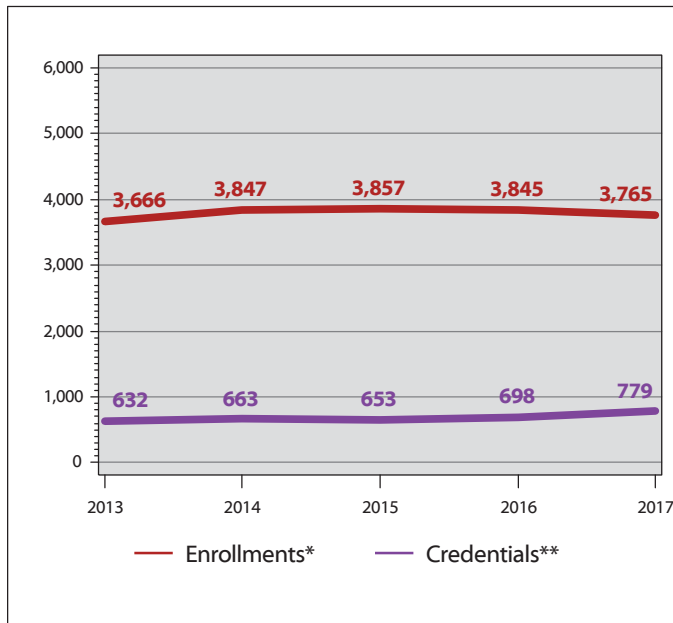
