APPLICATION TIMETABLE

Study for the GRE	Now! At least 4 months prior to attempting the test.
Register for the GRE	Register early (60-90 days prior) for the date and location you desire (seats are limited). Cost, \$205.
GRE	The computer-based GRE is given year-round.
CASPA Online App.	Primary application to PA school, you may begin working on it in April, and it should be submitted by July 1 st (deadlines vary). Cost, \$179+ \$52/school.
Letters of Evaluation	After you complete your application, contact your advisor.
Secondary Applications	Submit as soon as you can adequately complete.
Interviews	Offers as early as mid-January with interviews occurring in February
Acceptances	As early as March but as late as May

OTHER INFORMATION

- There are 196 accredited PA education programs in the U.S. and District of Columbia.
- You will view your unofficial Verbal and Quant GRE scores at the test center (computer-based)
- Scholarships and other forms of Financial Aid are available, most students take out loans
- You should get 1000 hours experience, volunteer, shadow and/or work in a health setting
- Join Alpha Epsilon Delta, the pre-health professions honor society
- Most PA programs award a master's degree over about 27 months
